As you will be aware, Year 11's at Stoke Park are **The Architects**: they have spent the year working hard to create a path for their future to fulfil their ambitions. This is a significant event in celebrating the secondary experience of any child as it symbolises the end of their GCSEs and beginning of the next stage in their education, but it is also an event that we hold to celebrate their participation, commitment, and motivation. We are very proud of Year 11 and how hard they have been working, so look forward to the opportunity to celebrate with them following the conclusion of their exams in July.

As part of rewarding our students for their hard work and an added incentive, students can earn money off the price of their Prom ticket that will be subsidised by the school. Any students who meet one of the following criteria will be eligible for this discount.

- Any Students that have **95 % attendance from September 2023 until 20<sup>th</sup> of June 2024**, attended all interventions and been on time **will get £10 off**.
- Any students that will have **100 % attendance from 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2024 to the 20<sup>th</sup> of June 2024** and will be on time, attended all interventions **will get £5 off**.

**Important notice: Smoking, vaping, or the consumption of alcohol before or during the event are strictly prohibited. Any students who fail to follow this guidance will not be allowed entry and will be sent home. Thank you for your support on this matter.**
