



## STOKE PARK — SCHOOL —

Dear Parent/Carer,

With only one half term left of the academic year, we are writing to you to ensure that our student's maintain the highest standards for the remainder of the year, and uphold the school values of PRIDE in all aspects of their school life.

Firstly, we would like to highlight the importance of attendance over the coming half term. The final half term is a key opportunity to reflect on the learning of the year so far, and to ensure that students have the essential skills necessary, ready to transition into the next stage of their Seven Year Journey. Students must be in school every day in order to access this learning. Additionally, students need to be on time to school and in their tutor rooms by 08:40; the PSHE and RSE curriculum provides our students with essential knowledge on their lives within Britain and the wider world, developing their interpersonal skills and understanding of the community they live in.

In addition, we would like to also remind all of our students about the expected uniform. All students need to wear their Stoke Park blazer, with a tucked in shirt, trousers or a skirt which are in the Uniform Policy, and smart black shoes. In particular relation to skirts, these should be a plain black knee length skirt, cotton/polyester/viscose. School trousers should also be regular school trousers, and not lycra or flares. Furthermore, we would also appreciate your support in relation to make-up. Students should not be wearing make-up to school, and are allowed one item of jewellery. Nose piercings are not part of the allowed uniform.

Finally, we would just like to remind all students about the use of mobile phones on school site. Mobile phones should not be out, seen or heard whilst students are on school site, and this includes at the beginning and the end of each day. If students are not adhering to this policy, then their mobile phones will be placed in reception to be collected by yourselves, alongside a meeting with the Director of Year Group.
