Consultation on proposed significant change – increase in physical capacity: 7 additional classrooms and ICT space.

I am writing to notify you of the consultation regarding Stoke Park School. The consultation period will run for 3 weeks and will take place from 08th September 2025. During this time, parents and other stakeholders are invited to express their views and any concerns about proposed increase to the physical capacity of 7 additional classrooms and an ICT space.

This consultation forms part of a Significant Change application to the Department for Education to expand the facilities at Stoke Park School with the addition of 7 classrooms and an ICT space.

The Board of Trustees and the Local Governing Committee are seeking to consult interested parties regarding an expansion in teaching space. The increase in teaching space is due to an increase in student numbers per year group from 180 to 210 from September 2025. This consultation is solely about the expansion of physical capacity (buildings) and not the increase in students. A consultation in relation to student numbers has already taken place.
