# Stoke Park School Uniform

## Essential Items:

- Black blazer.
- Plain white cotton shirt with collar.
- School tie.
- Plain black trousers. Straight cut cotton/polyester/viscose, **NOT LYCRA SKINTIGHT, BOOT CUT OR SKINNY.**
- A plain black knee length skirt, cotton/polyester/viscose, **NOT ELASTANE, LYCRA material.**
- Plain dark coloured socks or 60 denier black tights.
- Plain classic formal leather shoes – **NOT BOOTS, TRAINERS OR TRAINER STYLE.**
- Plain black coat – **NOT HOODIE, SPORTING OR TRACK SUIT TOPS.**
- School bag suitable for carrying exercise books and equipment.



## Optional

- Black V-neck school jumper with school logo.
- Plain black religious headwear (headscarves and turbans).

We do not allow – *you will be asked to remove any of the items below if you are wearing them in school;*

- More than one item of jewellery. Earrings must be small studs.
- Facial piercings.
- T-shirts visible under shirts.
- Extreme hairstyles or brightly coloured hair. · Make-up, nail varnish, acrylic nails.
- Baseball caps.

- Stoke Park girl's quarter zip top.
- Stoke Park polo shirt
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms or shorts – no logos.
- Plain long black sports socks, white or black sport ankle socks with no patterns/logos.
- Trainers (not pumps).
