Dear parent/carer,

We are at an exceptionally exciting part of your child's seven-year journey through Stoke Park School where they will be starting the process of choosing their GCSE options. As the Revolutionary in Year 9, the whole year is about our students considering the futures they want to build and develop for themselves, both in terms of their career pathways and the community they live in. It is essential students are fully informed about their potential option choices and take time to consider and weigh up the best choices for them.

To best support our students with their decision process, we are hosting an information webinar to begin the process. This will be taking place on Thursday 23rd April 2026 in order to provide information and provide you and your child with the opportunity to ask any questions you may have. The webinar will last for 30-45 minutes, and will present information about what GCSEs are, the subjects on offer at Stoke Park School, and how the options process works.

In order to join this session, it is essential to sign up in advance to Zoom webinar. It will run from 17:30-18:15. Further to this information evening, student's will be receiving Options Booklets, which contain an overview of each subject, how it is assessed, and some career pathways that subject may lead to. Every student in Year 9 will also be supported by their tutor around making their options but can also speak to Mr Grimwood, Mrs Tunilla or Miss Clayton for additional support. Personal 1-1 meetings can also be arranged for further guidance if required, please just get in touch in order to arrange this. Additionally, classroom teachers will be discussing their subjects at GCSE in lessons, and so it is key that student's attend school every day, so that they do not miss any information which may help them with their decisions. We will also have guest presentations from Heads of Department in Year 9 assemblies, which take place on Thursday mornings.
