Year 11 Intervention – The Next 20 School Days Matter

Dear Parent/Carer

As we approach the first Year 11 mock examinations, which begin during the week commencing **Monday 12 October**, the next few weeks are an extremely important period for our students.

From **next week**, we will begin our programme of targeted **Year 11 after-school intervention**. These sessions are designed to provide additional, focused support in the subjects where we believe it will have the greatest impact on each student's progress.

Friday	Options	<u>Why is intervention so important?</u>

Our experience shows that **students who engage consistently with targeted intervention can make significant improvements in their outcomes**. These additional sessions give teachers valuable time to address gaps in knowledge, revisit challenging content, develop examination technique and provide focused support ahead of the mock examinations.

However, intervention works best alongside excellent **attendance, punctuality and independent study**. Students should continue to complete all Learning Prep and undertake regular revision at home. We recommend approximately **1–2 hours of focused independent study each school day**, including Learning Prep.

The **next 20 school days really matter**. When students apply to sixth forms, colleges and other post-16 destinations, their mock examination performance, attendance and punctuality may form an important part of those conversations and applications. We therefore need every Year 11 student to attend school regularly, arrive on time, engage fully in lessons and attend the intervention sessions allocated to them.

Prom Attendance Incentive

We also want to recognise and reward students who demonstrate excellent attendance during this important period. Students who maintain **at least 95% attendance over the next 20 school days will receive £10 off the cost of their Year 11 Prom ticket**. We hope this provides an additional positive incentive while reinforcing our key message: **every day in school matters**.

Please support us by speaking to your child about the importance of the next few weeks and ensuring that they attend their allocated intervention sessions. **Every lesson, every intervention and every day in school counts**.
