Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you about the introduction of **MathsWatch**, our online Maths homework platform. MathsWatch will be used to support students with their learning outside the classroom, provide regular opportunities to practise key mathematical skills and help students consolidate the topics covered during lessons.

What is MathsWatch?

MathsWatch is an online learning platform designed specifically for Mathematics. It provides students with interactive questions, instant feedback and helpful video explanations. One of its main benefits is that **each question is supported by a video**, so if a student becomes stuck or is unsure how to approach a question, they can watch the relevant video for additional guidance before trying again.

Regular use of MathsWatch will help students to:

- practise and strengthen the skills taught during Maths lessons;
- develop confidence and independence in Mathematics;
- receive immediate feedback on their answers;
- revisit topics and learn from mistakes; and
- prepare effectively for assessments and examinations.

Homework Arrangements

Maths homework will be assigned by class teachers every Monday and will be due the following Monday. This gives students one full week to complete their assigned work.

Students are encouraged to organise their time carefully and avoid leaving their homework until the final evening. They should make use of the supporting MathsWatch videos whenever they need additional help.

How to Access MathsWatch

Class teachers have provided students with their individual MathsWatch login details. These details have been **stuck into students' planners** so that they can easily access them at home.

Step 1: Go to the MathsWatch website:

Step 2: Enter your username and password.

Username: Your username has been provided by your class teacher and is stuck in your planner.

Password: Your initial password is the **same as your username**.



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Step 3: Please **personalise/change your password as soon as possible** to help keep your account secure. Students should choose a password that they can remember and should not share it with other students.

Forgotten or Lost Passwords

If, for any reason, your child loses or forgets their MathsWatch password and is unable to access their account, please email their Maths teacher to request assistance.
