Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Pupil Premium

The Pupil Premium (PP) is additional funding given to schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the achievement gap between them and their peers. The funding is available to the following groups of students:

- Students who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM).
- Students that have been eligible for FSM in the last six years (FSM Ever 6)
- Students who are in care or previously have been in care
- Students who are under special guardianship.
- Students from a forces background.

The funding for each of these groups of students must be used to support the students or take away financial barriers that could be hindering their progress within school. The government expects the school to track each of the student's progress and how the funding is being spent.

If you receive one of the following benefits your child is entitled to FSMs and will therefore generate Pupil premium funding for the school:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
- The guaranteed element of the State Pension Credit
- Income-related employment and support allowances
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400

- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

**If your child qualifies for free school meals but takes a packed lunch, it's still important that you tell us and submit a free school meals application**, as this will enable us to claim Pupil Premium funding on their behalf.

Applying for Pupil Premium funding is simple. Fill out the Free School Meals application form and return it to the Local Authority. I have attached the link to Coventry City Council website below.
