English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each student will receive an English Language pack, containing past papers and practice papers for both Paper 1 (creative texts) and Paper 2 (non-fiction, writers' viewpoints and perspectives). Additionally, all pupils will be receiving and are expected to complete both a full Language Paper One and Language Paper Two.</li> <li>• For Literature, pupils will be receiving a selection of revision booklets from their class teacher to support their revision for key texts of study. Within each booklet, are a selection of exam style / past questions.</li> </ul>
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete past papers</li> </ul>
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• students will have key words &amp; definitions to learn, powerful knowledge questions, and exam questions for each paper 2 topic covered so far, along with the key concepts in biology, chemistry and physics which appear on paper 1 and 2.</li> </ul>
Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1x paper 1 knowledge organiser</li> <li>• 1x paper 2 knowledge organiser</li> <li>• Students need to make flashcards based on these and quiz each other/find someone at home to quiz them on them</li> <li>• 1x paper 3 factfile</li> <li>• Students need to make flashcards based on these and quiz each other/find someone at home to quiz them on them</li> <li>• 1x set of fieldwork exam questions to be completed in their books and returned first Monday back</li> </ul>
BTEC SPORT	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Any student who is retaking the Unity 1 online exam, the second Thursday back will be provided with a range of past papers and mark schemes. They are to complete these over easter in timed conditions, mark their own work, 1 hour per paper for 50 marks. They then need to revise the areas that they got wrong using the revision guides given to them.</li> <li>2. Unit 3 coursework to be completed to their TG or better.</li> </ol>
History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mind Maps - jotting down everything they know and using a different colour to add any missing information from textbooks/notes/videos</li> <li>• Answering exam style questions and asking a member of staff to mark for feedback</li> <li>• Flash cards</li> </ul>

French	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Your revision booklet is based on your speaking exam, you will need to complete the role plays , photocard and finesse speaking question replies that are at the back of the book. The speaking exam is after Easter, so it is imperative that this is completed. The booklet is for both foundation and higher students.</li> </ul>
Media	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Revision packs for both papers will be given to students. Paper one is the exam that covers the shorter texts: print advertising, movie posters, magazines, newspapers, radio and video games. Paper two covers the TV and Music video units and requires a wider understanding. The packs will feature fact sheets, knowledge organisers as well as exam style questions that students should work through to break down to make revision more accessible for themselves to support the summer exam workload. The work will also be supported by texts and task sheets up on the year 11 Media Teams channel.</li> </ul>
Computer Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students have been bought a revision guide and Exam Tutor. Students will be expected to complete all paper 1 revision in their exam tutor booklets. Students have also been set revision questions on the website <a href="http://www.educake.co.uk">www.educake.co.uk</a></li> </ul>
